The next WALG World Left-Handed Championship will be held in Paris, France from August 17-21, 2020.

The courses to be played include both L'Albatross and L'Aigle at the Golf National, site of the 2018 Ryder Cup; and also Golf de Saint Cloud, founded in 1913, and Golf de la Boulie, founded in 1901. All of the courses have hosted many professional golf tournaments and remain a challenge for golfers.

The host hotel will be Le Méridien Étoile, located at 81 Boulevard Gouvion St Cyr in Paris, not far from the Arc de Triomphe.
